My name is **Sándor Patrik Györgye**, I am 25 years old, the leader of the congregation in Soltvadkert. I live here with my wife and two children, and my parents-in-law. In 2013, the Lord spoke to me in a church in Kiskőrös. I realised that everything that was missing from my life can only be found in the Lord. Glory to God, I have been following Him diligently ever since.

## COMMUNITY

I serve in the Soltvadkert Community Center, which currently has 20-25 people. 17 to 18 people are of Roma origin and the rest are of Hungarian origin. They are between the ages of 5 to 50. Worship services usually last 2 hours. We start with worship, then we listen to the word of God and we leave some time at the end for testimonies and prayer.





## Family background and ministry plans

God has blessed me with a wonderful family. I have a 6-year-old son, Máté, a 4-month-old son, Áron, and my wife, Krisztina. I work as an auxiliary worker in the construction industry.

I grew up in Kiskőrös as a child with my two older sisters, my older brother and a younger sister. Glory to God, my parents are Christians and I owe a great deal to them, I have developed a lot through them. I studied to be a room painter but unfortunately I was not able to finish school because I had to help out the family. I went to work in agriculture to help my parents make a living. I have prayed a lot for God to make our lives better.

One day my father had a heart attack and the doctors said there was no hope. That is when I turned to the Lord for help. I was reminded of the story from the Bible when Jesus cursed the fig tree and it became dry and dead and his disciples marvelled at this and he told them: , So I tell you to ask for what you want in prayer. And if you believe that you have received those things, then they will be yours.” Mark 11:24

I believed with all my heart that my father would be healed and glory to God he was. There and then, I have decided to seek the Lord wholeheartedly and asked him to give me a community to join. I prayed a lot and three days later I met Brother Jozsef Rostás, the leader of the church in Kiskőrös, and he invited me to his home group, where I got to meet Pál Péter, the pastor.

I have financial difficulties, it is hard to cover the expenses. I usually solve this problem with working overtime. There was a time when I could not find a job, but I had big plans for Soltvadkert. I wanted to donate food to those in need, which would have required money. I prayed a lot and called all my friends and family to help out and God provided everything that we needed.

Before Christ, I lacked love in my life. Even then, I loved people, I just felt like I



was not loved, that no one was listening to me, no one understood me, no one cared about me, and I did not know where to put my trust. But then I had to realise that the living God cares for me, he loves me and will not leave me because he promised. Amen.

God has entrusted me with preaching, to teach people the Bible, to talk about Him, and to tell everyone how good and gracious He is. I really enjoy doing His work. My goal is to see the awakening and to lead as many people as possible to the Lord. This is my calling! We have difficulties many times, but we trust in God and we know that He is our solution!

## CTL programme

What I expect from the training programme is to learn as much as I can about the word of God so I can preach effectively in the church as well.

I have already developed a lot during the training and I am very happy to be taught in practice how to preach the word.

In Soltvadkert I lead the church and glory to God, the number of the congregation as well as the number of people is expanding and this is a great development.

I want us to multiply, because that is God's plan, and to have more services every week. I still have a lot to learn in order to get there, but that is why I applied for the training, because here I get all the help I need.
