I started and finished primary school in Budapest. I continued my studies in computer programming, but I was not able to finish it there because we moved to Szabolcs county, where I finally got my high school diploma.

MINISTRY

My service is most often in Kótaj, next to Mihály Rézműves, the local pastor. In Kántorjánosi we usually have a home group where we talk about God and his miracles with 4-5 people. They are between the ages of 20-26.

I think my generation is teachable and receptive to God's word. I try to encourage them to talk about God so that as many people as possible can get to know Him.

My plan for the upcoming period is to pass on the word of God to as many young people as possible. In this way, we can train more people, because the legacy of the elders is carried on by the young people.

I work in the GypsyAid and want to improve and expand my biblical knowledge. I am committed to teaching young people. I want to show them the right direction and help them in everything. The most important goal is to carry on the legacy we receive in order to improve our impact on the world.

One of our difficulties is the lack of technical equipment. Today's youth is mostly present in social media, where they can be best reached, but for that we need tools.



Family background

I met my wife, Dalma in 2010. We got to know each other for 4 years, then in 2014 we got married. After 3 years, our first boy child, Enzo was born. He is a miracle from God, after many years of unsuccessful attempts, the doctors suggested surgery, but God intervened and gifted us with a boy. At the age of 3, we took him to several examinations because he had not yet spoken, and he was diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder. However, we know that God only allows as much burden as we can bear. 3 years later, in 2020, we had another miracle, our second baby girl named Lia came unexpectedly. My heart is very grateful for my two children. After Enzo was born, we did not think that we could have another child, but the Lord sees the conditions of our hearts and He knows exactly when and what we need.

I owe a lot to my grandparents. They showed me the way of God and I grew up next to them in the church. From the age of 8, we went to church in Kótaj every weekend. We traveled 600km back and forth to serve there and spared no effort. They are my role models.

I currently live in Kántorjánosi with my family. I consider myself very blessed because I was born into a Christian family. I heard the name of Jesus Christ since birth, and when I was 12, I gave my heart to Jesus.

CTL Programme

I expect from the program to teach me how to pass on my knowledge to others. I have already developed a lot and expanded my knowledge. I want to progress so that I can pass on God's word and love well so that young people could do the same.

I want to lead people to find a solution to their own problems. I want to introduce the young to the word of God, to help the elderly and to further develop what I have learned.

I want as many young people as possible to come and do the service and the work of God. Mostly, my grandfather (Ferenc Mihály Rézműves) motivated me to apply for this training, his life and service are my role model. Many people have come to Jesus because of him and I want to follow his example.
